



Make Music Day Australia invites Australians to Create Your Own Stage!

Make Music Day is a free celebration of music making around the world, taking place on 21 June each year. Launched in 1982 in France as the Fête de la Musique, Make Music Day is celebrating its 40th Anniversary - it is now held on the same day in more than a thousand cities in 125 countries. And now for a fourth year in Australia.

Different from a typical music festival, Make Music Day is open to anyone who wants to take part. It's a DIY Music Festival! Every kind of musician — young and old, amateur and professional, of every musical persuasion — can organise their own gig, or join the many organisations that will host events, to share their music with friends, neighbours, and strangers. All of it must be free and open to the public.

Musicians can participate in many ways | from getting some mates together and putting on a gig in the park rotunda to making a live video of your music and posting it on the Make Music Day website and on social media | live stream a performance or playing with their bands. The principle is that it is all free.

Hundreds of events in as many locations around Australia have been hosted for Make Music Day. In 2021, like many events, it went online and attracted tens of thousands of views of live music as part of this global event.
